The nursing interventions you will do</li> <li>2. The rationale for why you selected those nursing interventions.</li> </ol> <p>The nursing interventions should be nurse-centric, and should be written as, "The nurse will..."</p> <p>The rationales should be evidence-based, meaning, through research, they have been shown to work.</p>	<p>This one has 2 sections:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. If the patient met their goal, what new goal will you set?</li> <li>2. If the patient did not meet their goal, what will you change in the care plan to help them meet their goal in the future.</li> </ol>
